COMMUNITY NEWS AND EVENTS

The Presbyterian Church in Canada **invites 19-25-year-old youth to apply for the Journey for Justice program** in July 2023 (arrival date is July 8, and departure on July 16) by May 12, 2023. Experience the daily life of Palestinian youth, listen to their stories under occupation and conflict, see first-hand how occupying measures impact them, and tour different cities in Palestine with them.

Supported by Presbyterians Sharing, the PCC covers airfare, travel VISAs (if applicable) and a participation fee that covers accommodation, local transportation, meals and entry fees. Participants are asked to contribute \$1,000 towards the total cost and will be responsible for additional incidental costs.
