BRACELETS FOR SYDNEY

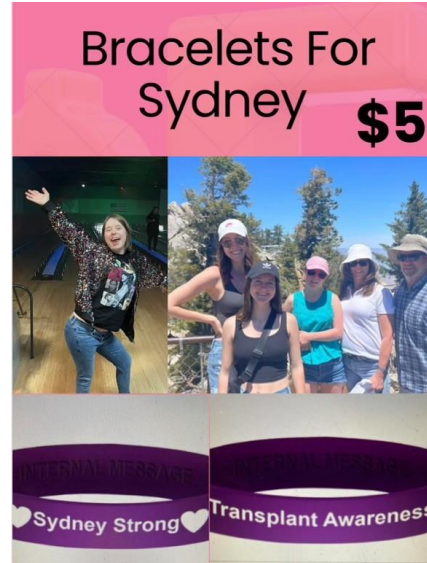
A very kind friend of Sydney Vrolyk has made "Sydney Strong" bracelets!! They will be available outside the office after the service for \$5 each.
