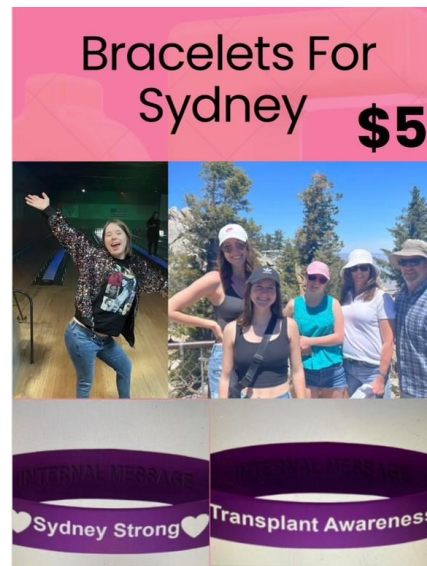
WANTED
