

PRAYER PARTNERSHIP: DAILY PRAYERS

Sunday, November 16 (Legacy Giving Sunday) We pray for all the people in congregations who leave a legacy gift—a bequest, a charitable gift annuity or a gift of life insurance—to the church, so that we may have vibrant ministry, today and tomorrow.

Monday, November 17 (Restorative Justice Week – Nov 16-23) We pray for the healing of all people impacted by crime and violence and for an end to the systemic root causes of conflict and violence (including barriers to affordable housing, education, living wages, healthy food and healthcare), that all people may be safe and thrive.

Tuesday, November 18 We pray for chaplains in hospitals and long-term care homes as they continue to provide comfort, offer hope and minister during moments that matter.

Wednesday, November 19 We pray for the safe travel and wellbeing of the National Indigenous Ministries Council as they meet in person (November 19-21).

Thursday, November 20 (Trans Day of Remembrance/World Children's Day) We remember those who have died because of transphobic violence and pray for an end to hatred. We commit to creating safer communities where people of all genders can thrive.

Friday, November 21 We give thanks for the scholarship of the members of the Canadian Society of Presbyterian History; may their work help the church to better understand where we are through learning about where we have been.

Saturday, November 22 (National Housing Day) We pray that all people have access to safe, adequate and affordable housing and we give thanks for advocates working to remove systemic barriers to accessing affordable housing.
