80 ACTS OF KINDNESS MISCARRIAGE BASKET MINISTRY

Miscarriage and the emergency medical care that come with it can be a frightening and isolating experience for Women. As part of our Acts of Kindness Campaign, Cassandra is working to create baskets for women who need medical care at Bluewater Health following a miscarriage.

Each basket includes items such as a journal, pen, tea, cozy socks, hair clip, lip balm, tissues, facial cleansing wipes, a scripture based bookmark, and a handwritten note of comfort. These baskets offer a small sense of dignity and care along with reassurance that they are not alone in a vulnerable time.

The hospital has indicated they need approximately 20 baskets each year. We have put together 5 to get them through the summer and are hoping to create an additional 20 in the fall to ensure they are covered this year.
